RECISION OF ORDER UNDER SECTION 244(2) AND 238

WHEREAS the Superintendent of Financial Institutions (the "Superintendent") made an Order (the "Order") pursuant to section 244(2) and 238 of the Financial Institutions Act, (the "Act") dated the 28th day of November, 2003, that First Capital Trading & Finance Corp., First Capital Credit Corp., and South Bank & Trust Co. Ltd., immediately:

- Cease from either directly or indirectly carrying on trust business in British Columbia, including advertising trust opportunities and soliciting trust business.
- 2. Cease from either directly or indirectly carrying on deposit business in British Columbia, including advertising deposit opportunities, and soliciting deposit business.
- Cease using the word "deposit" and other words in any way likely to deceive or mislead the public about their ability to carry on deposit business in British Columbia.
- 4. Cease using the word "trust" and other words in any way likely to deceive or mislead the public about their ability to carry on trust business in British Columbia, or to give the false impression that they are trust companies.

AND WHEREAS it has been determined that South Bank & Trust Co. Ltd. is a British West Indies Corporation and was not:

- 1. Either directly or indirectly carrying on trust business in the British Columbia;
- 2. Either directly or indirectly carrying on deposit business in British Columbia;
- 3. Using the word "deposit" and other words in any way likely to deceive or mislead the public about their ability to carry on deposit business in British Columbia;
- 4. Using the word "trust" and other words in any way likely to deceive or mislead the public about their ability to carry on trust business in British Columbia, or to give the false impression that they are trust companies.

NOW THEREFORE the Superintendent hereby rescinds the Order only with respect to South Bank & Trust Co. Ltd.
